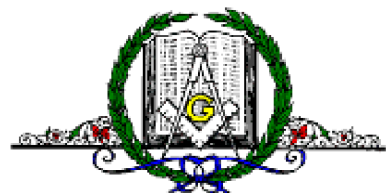

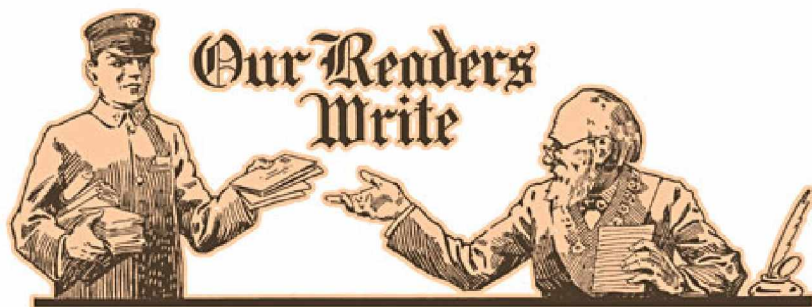
Colin Cook is the grandson of Ex. Companion Bruce Gordon who was on hand for the presentation. Congratulations Colin and best wishes on your future studies.

The La Cloche Mountain Ramblers entertained the guests with good old mountain charm.

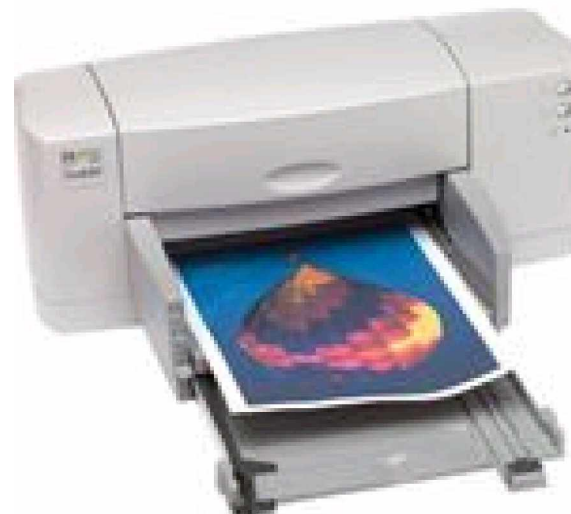
