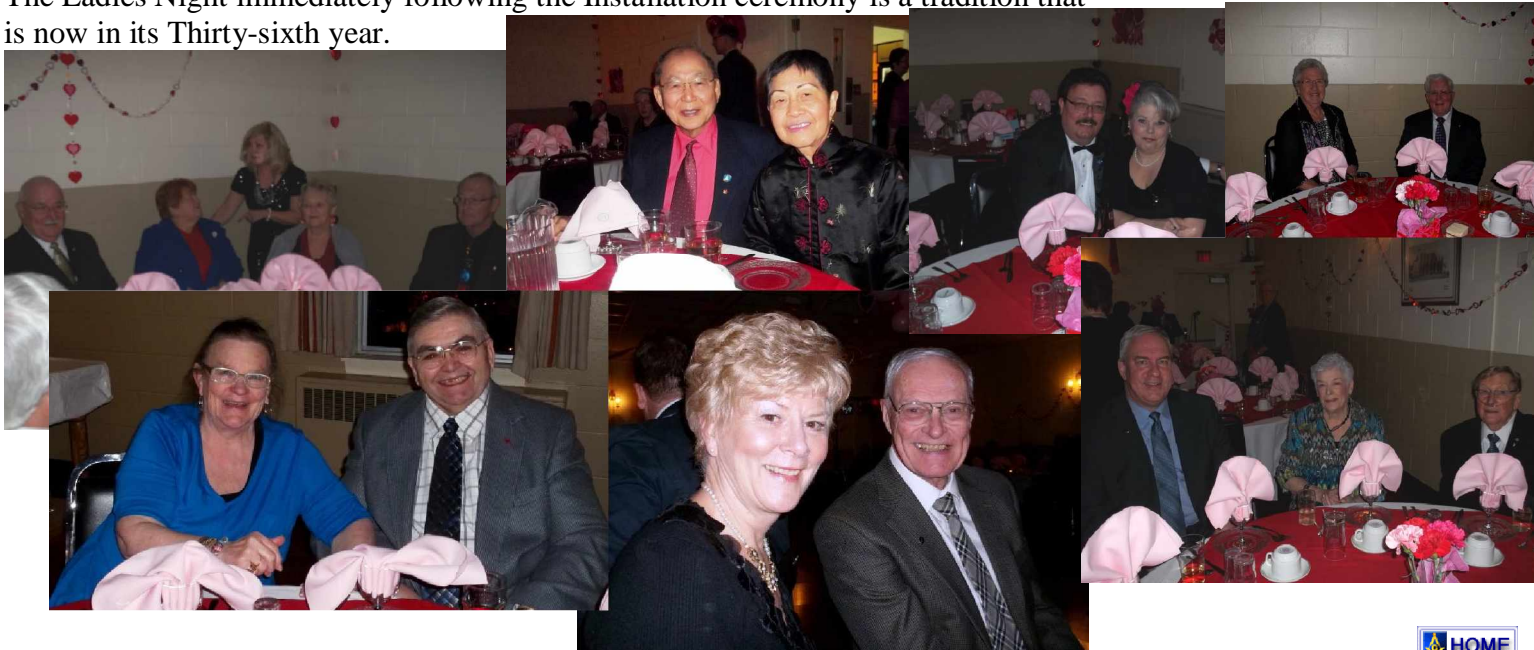

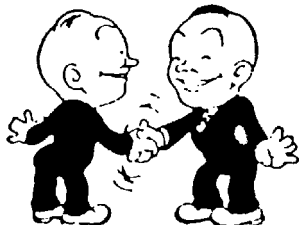

The orders of the Masonic Knights Templar are part of a progression from the first three degrees of Freemasonry. Membership thus involves several prerequisites:

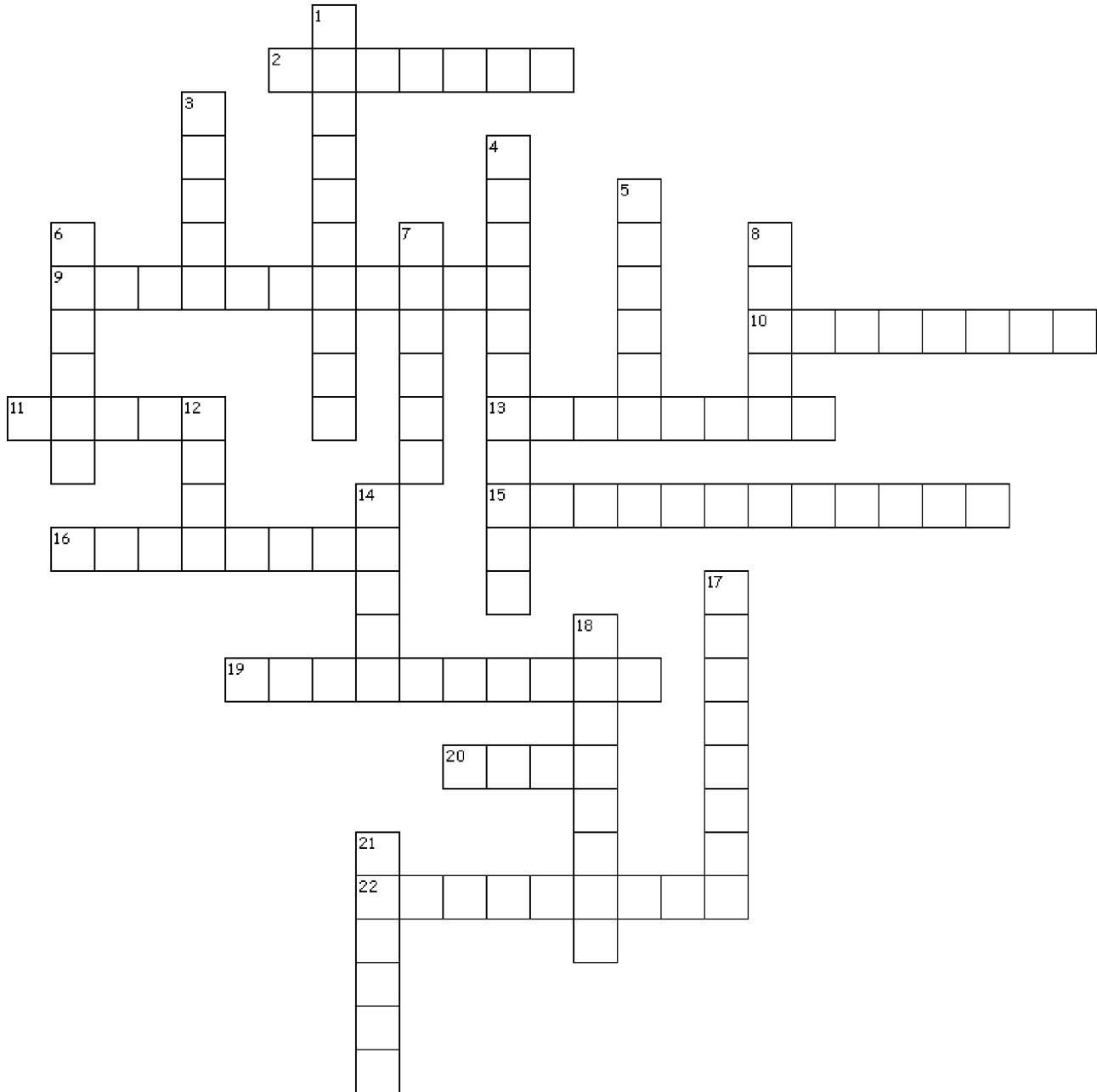

## ROUTE FROM HIGHWAY TO HOLIDAY INN



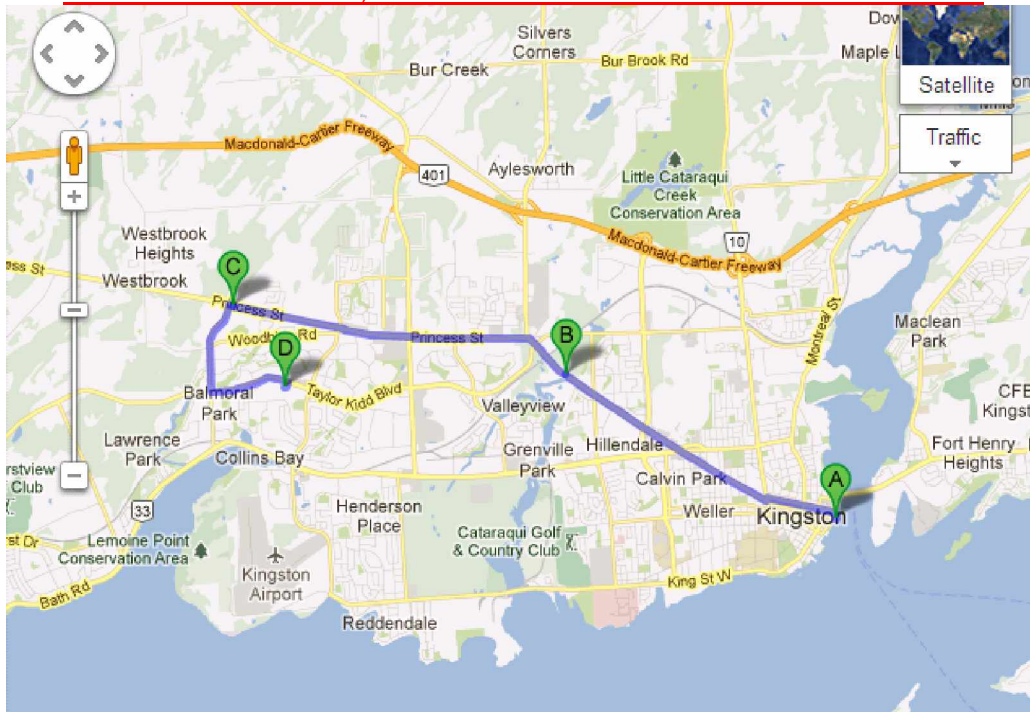
